Dunlop Flooring is committed to reducing landfill, the objective of this scheme is to reduce impact on the environment through recycling products, we have been successfully recycling Carpet Underlay for over 20 years and now we are proud to add vinyl flooring to our recycling scheme. We encourage our retail partners to get involved and make a positive impact on the environment through collecting post-consumer vinyl flooring across Australia for Dunlop Flooring to collect and recycle it into new flooring or 'second-life' products.

How does this help the environment?

Our objective is to collect over 10 tonnes of PVC flooring per year!

This equates to nearly 175,200m² of PVC flooring or enough to cover the MCG 22 times! That's a saving of over 330 tonnes of CO₂ gases or equivalent to taking 500 cars off the road for a year!



What can you contribute?

Acceptable items to recycle:

- + Clean, smooth vinyl flooring offcuts or roll-ends.
- + Clean offcuts of luxury vinyl tiles (LVT).
- + Uplifted and clean offcuts of loose lay.
- + Uplifted, smooth vinyl flooring, clean top surface with no more screed or adhesive on the rear than vinyl.

Items we cannot accept:

- General waste, including, asbestos, rubble, wood, blades, nails, screws, liquids, etc.
- Floors from buildings constructed prior to 1990.
- Wood and Laminate flooring.
- Wet, mouldy, or weathered flooring.
- Product containing concrete/floor prep or fabric backing.

How is Vinyl Flooring Collected?

You can help us by following two simple steps:

1. Deposit clean vinyl off cuts, smooth uplifted contaminant free vinyl planks or old (clean stock ONLY).
2. **Recycled content can be dropped off at a dedicated drop off zone as stated below;**
